

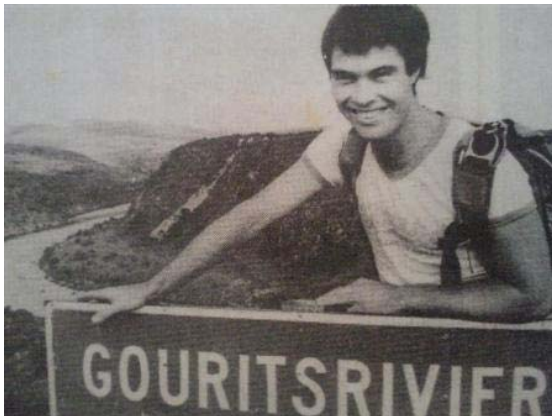
About Neil

Riding Experience: Started in 1980, rode for a few years. Resumed after a long break. Total experience approximately 10 years.

The first bike I owned was a Honda CB400N. The day after I took delivery, I rode it to Velddrift, 2 days later to Rundu in Namibia. There on Military Service, rode the dirt roads to go fishing in my spare time.



Just before finishing up my Military Service, I started skydiving. Then rode the bike through Namibia, home to Cape Town.

Skydiving was the main activity for the next 4 years, and I ended up with South African and American instructor ratings, +- 15 BASE jumps, including the first BASE jump off a cliff in Africa, and about 930 jumps from aircraft.



After a number of years I started riding again - first a 250cc scooter, which I still have, then a Suzuki 650 V-Strom. Now for the past 3 years on a BMW R1200GS.



After taking part in a few track training days, I was drawn back to training after seeing how much I benefitted. Now it is time to put back into motorcycling.
